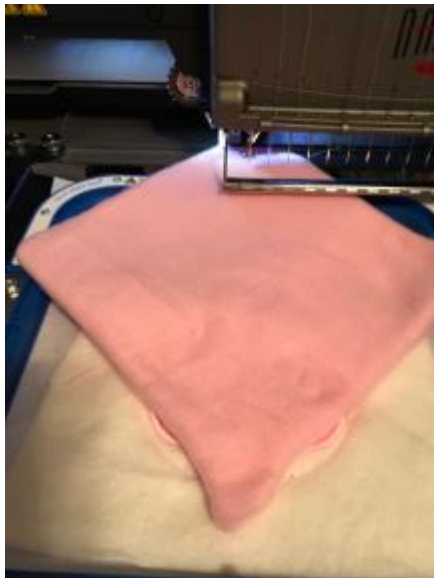


Use a Peekaboo design to make a lovie

Make the Peekaboo as you normally would until the 2nd to last step – the curve along the bottom of the egg.



Using either your software or right at your machine, you will run that step twice
Run once to mark where your blanket will be attached



Lay the blanket **RIGHT SIDE DOWN** over the body of the Peekaboo, with just the part you want to attach extending over the line you just stitched



Repeat that step to tack the blanket down



Pull the blanket down out of the way – it will now be hanging off the edge of your machine with the right side facing up



Lay your back fabric RIGHT SIDE DOWN over your egg, with the blanket hanging off the edge
Run the final stitch to attach the back. The turn hole will be where your blanket is hanging out, so it should not get caught in the final step. If it looks like it might, you may want to fold the edges in to keep it clear.



You will now have an inside out egg with the blanket hanging out of the bottom of it.

Trim around the egg



Flip right side out

Tuck the corner of your blanket inside the egg

Stuff, sew your turning hole closed
